Junior contracts engineer

Deals with the identification and contracting of suppliers, preparing the tender process. Carries out analyses to identify the Vendor List, verifying the technical, corporate and compliance characteristics of the companies identified. Takes care of establishing the contractual conditions through negotiation. Acts in challenging contexts, which require a passionate approach.

Junior R&D engineer

Plans and follows the testing activities within Eni projects in collaboration with the internal and external multidisciplinary work team. Oversees the drafting of technical documentation and project specifications in collaboration with national and international research laboratories and bodies: multicultural contexts that recognize diversity as an added value.

Junior HSEQ engineer

Carries out technical audits, including verification of compliance with the 231 HSE and Health control standards, and regulatory compliance checks. Carries out reporting activities, with reference to the acquisition of the results of technical audits and related intervention plans. Discusses with their work team, thus increasing their skills and experience in the field.

Biofixation analyst

Assists in carrying out studies related to the biofixing process, identifying areas requiring improvement and offering viable solutions. Works with the plant manager to manage, monitor and optimize production operations. The professional context is challenging and constantly evolving.

Waste management analyst

Coordinates and manages the activities aimed at waste management and its delivery to the carrier. Prepares the necessary documentation to ensure the traceability of waste from production to disposal. Together with the team, carries out a significant activity for the future of the energy industry.

Environmental processes analyst

Develops process engineering in the field of groundwater treatment and chemical-physical and biological remediation systems. Draws up and revises documents relating to general process specifications, material selection, equipment list and operating manuals. It carries out its activity in an international context, which promotes the professional contribution of each member and enhances uniqueness.

Bonification and demolition techniques analyst

Manages the administrative part of projects and external suppliers related to remediation activities. Interfaces with public bodies for the discussion and approval of project documents. Commitment and passion for their work are elements that characterize those who work in this field.

Carbon Capture, Utilization & Storage analyst

Contributes to the development of cutting-edge technologies to capture carbon dioxide and reuse it for the production of innovative fuels and products. Plays a strategic role in the decarbonization process to ensure a sustainable and energy-efficient future.

Forestry initiatives analyst*

Provides support in forest offset management activities aimed at reducing GHG emissions, rural development and biodiversity conservation. Specifically, carries out analysis and estimation of emission reductions and greenhouse gas absorption of offset projects, working alongside Eni for a low-carbon future.
